

Our career development program enshrines the students with such skills which may help them in the promotion of their expertise. We not only develop the expertise in the students but also teach them to utilize those expertise'.


Modern Educational Facilities





RULES AND REGULATIONS



- 1. Admission to various classes in Premier Group of Colleges Gujranwala is granted on merit strictly and in accordance with rules & regulation, policies, and procedures of the college.
- 2. The candidates, who fulfill the requirements and conditions prescribed by the university in the college rules, are eligible for admission.
- 3. An application for admission shall be made on the prescribed form, which may be obtained from the college office during office hours.
- 4. The Admission form shall be filled by the candidate in his/her own handwriting, and shall be signed by him/her as well as his/her parent/guardian.
- 5. Copies of the following documents shall be annexed with the Form:
 - a. 4 copies of Academic Transcripts/Certificates/Degrees.
 - b. NOC, in case the applicant has not passed his last examination from University of The Punjab.
 - c. 6 passport size Photographs of applicant
 - d. Copy of Computerized National Identity Card
 - e. A certificate of good character, signed by the Principal/Head of the educational institution last attended.
- 6. Applications for admission will be accepted according to the schedule notified and no Application Form will be accepted after the last date except with the special permission of the Principal.
- After the completion of all the necessary stages of admission, the list of successful candidates will be displayed on the College Notice Board. Students who fail to pay all dues by the due date will find their right of admission forfeited.
- 8. College authorities can reject any candidate's application for admission on the ground of unbecoming character or conduct.
- 9. After the admission of a candidate, if it comes to knowledge of College Authorities at any stage, that the documents submitted by the candidate for admission carry a misstatement, or are fake, or there is an error in these documents, that may affect his/her merit, his/her admission will be cancelled.

Discipline

If any student does not comply with the code of conduct, misuses the leniency shown to him; or is involved in any activity which can lead others astray; or shows immoral character, we consider it necessary to take action against him in order to maintain the discipline. Such an action can be taken under the following conditions. Violating any rule of the college, which are enforced time to time, creating any short of anarchy or induce others to do so; arranging any meeting or procession without prior permission.

POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Fees & Dues

The details of Tuition Fee and other dues are given in Application form.

- Tuition Fee can be paid in four installments.
 1st Installment at the time of admission
 2nd Installment 1st week of December
 3rd Installment 1st week of February
 4th Installment 1st week of April
- 2. The Dues are payable in advance by such dates and in such manner as may be notified.
- 3. The name of the candidate, shall stand withdrawn, if he does not, pay the requisite dues within the time fixed, and his seat may be assigned to any other candidate.
- 4. If a student does not pay the dues by the date fixed for the purpose, a fine of Rs. 50/- per day will be charged up to the last working day of the month, where-after his name will automatically stand struck off from the college rolls, and, unless readmitted, he will not be allowed to attend any class.
- 5. The defaulter may, within 10 days from the day his name is so struck off, apply for re-admission, with specific reasons for non-payment of dues within the prescribed time.
- 6. The Principal, in his discretion, may re-admit him on the payment of the outstanding dues and a struck off fine of Rs1000/-
- 7. A student, who joins the College during the term, is charged full fee for the term,
- 8. Tuition Fees normally increases at the rate of 10-15% per year.
- 9. The Dues, once paid, are neither refundable nor transferable on any account whatsoever.

A very committed and an uncompromising attitude is adopted by Premier Group of Colleges to establish high standards of discipline in academic campus. A disciplinary committee has been constituted to observe the discipline in the college. Committee has been constituted. - Student ID Card




It is compulsory for every student to obtain his/her identity card from the College Office immediately upon admission. Defaulters will be fined. If an Identity card is lost, a new card will be issued for Rs. 100/-A student should carry his/her Identity card with him at all times and it must be produced on demand of any staff member. Non-possession of card can entail a fine of Rs. 50/- Refusal to show the Identity card can entail a heavy fine, which will not be remitted. A student's identity card is the property of the College. It is compulsory for every student to hand over his/her Identity Card to the College Office for record, upon being dropped from the College's rolls, or upon the termination of the College session.

RULES AND REGULATIONS



Attendance

Student must attend classes regularly. If absent for 6 consecutive days, any student can be expelled from the College. In case of expulsion, the student has to appeal for re-admission within 15 days time. If the student does not apply for re-admission, he will have to forego the right of re-admission. After re-admission if a student is expelled from the college, he/she will have 15 days to apply for re-admission for the second time, after which he will never be granted re-admission in any case thereof. In order to appear in exam, student must have at least 80% attendance; otherwise, the student will not be allowed to sit in exam. The principal can give concession of another 10% attendance if the student has been absent because of sickness or some other critical reason. Even in case of absence or leave, the student has to complete his course work.

Legal Essay Competition








CRIMINAL Mock Trial

Admission Criteria

Standard Entry Route

To be eligible to register for the LL. B the student must be at least 17 years of age at the time of registration and have passed:

- Either two subjects at GCE 'A' level and at least three further subjects at GCSE or GCE 'O' Level at grade C or above. OR
- Three subjects at GCE 'A' level and one further subject at GCSE or GCE 'O' Level at grade Cor above. OR
- Two subjects at GCE 'A' Level and two further subjects at 'AS' Level

Graduate Entry Route

There also exists the Graduate Entry Routine which it's required that you must be a graduate (16 Years of education) with a full first degree by examination awarded by an institution in Pakistan or elsewhere that is acceptable to the university. The Judicial System of Pakistan

The roots of the current judicial system of Pakistan stretch back to the medieval period and even before. Introduction to Law & Pakistani Legal System

Introduction to Law is a module for first year LLB students that will provide them with a brief insight of the fundamental areas of law that are taught at undergraduate level. The module covers a range of substantive legal principles and the law making framework in Pakistan. The course seeks to place law in its social, economic, political, historical and philosophical context and thus not only provides students with a knowledge of legal rules but also about the classification of laws in Pakistan and to help them develop a critical understanding of the operation of those rules in society.

This module comprehensively explains the Pakistani Legal System and Pakistan's standing into local and international community. Students will be familiarized with the court room ethics, learn techniques of statutory interpretation and how to read case notes. In addition, the course will incorporate usage of legal terminologies for students to enhance their presentation skills along with analytical and critical reasoning skills.

Professional Skills in Practice

From 2020/21 the academic stage of training, previously satisfied by completing a Qualifying Law Degree (QLD), will no longer be the same for both intending solicitors and barristers. Instead, the academic stage requirements will depend on the profession you wish to enter. Intending Barristers All intending barristers will need to meet the following criteria to satisfy the requirements of the academic stage of training:

- Complete their entire programme of study within six years (the six-year period will commence from the registration date (1 November or 1 May) preceding their first examination attempt)
- Pass examinations in the foundations of legal knowledge: Criminal law, Equity and Trusts, EU law, Contract law, Tort law, Property law, Public law
- Make no more than three examination attempts at any module
- Have demonstrated the attainment of various skills, including legal research and IT skills
- Additionally, Graduate Entry LLB students

PROGRESSING Through Your LLDStudies

In the first year, all Standard Entry LLB students must study and pass Legal system and method, and Graduate Entry students must study and pass the online course Introduction to English law.

Assessment

For all modules, except the Dissertation, assessment is primarily by three-hour examinations. These are held in May/June and October at local centers in over 190 different countries as well as in London. All examination scripts are marked by University of London approved academics.

Transitional Arrangements For Intending Solicitors

Anyone who has started, completed or accepted an offer for a Qualifying Law Degree by 31 December 2021 falls into the Solicitors Regulation Authority (SRA) transitionary arrangements. After completion of the LLB they can choose between the LPC route and the SQE route to complete as the vocational stage of training. The SQE Route requires a degree in any subject. The LPC route requires satisfactory completion of the academic stage set out in the section above for intending barristers. Satisfactory completion of the academic stage of legal training does not guarantee automatic admission to the next stage of training (vocational); acceptance will be dependent on your classification and results.

Practicing Law Outside England and Wales

If the students intend to practise law in a country other than England and Wales, they must confirm with the relevant professional authorities that they recognise the University of London LLB as fulfilling (in whole or in part) the academic stage requirements of legal training.




